

The Salmon and Freshwater Fisheries (Consolidation) (Scotland) Act 2003
Proposed Access as amended in The Aquaculture and Freshwater Fisheries (Scotland Act) August
2007 under Sections 48, 49(1)(2) and 50(1)(3)(4)
River Tay Protection Order

Updated Proposals made under Section 48(1) to (7) of the 2003 Act, and as amended within the 2007 Act, by or on behalf of the owner or occupier of a right to fish for freshwater fish species.

It is a Criminal Offence to fish for any Species, under the Act, with out Legal or written consent, i.e. suitable Identification or a Permit.
